THE PROJECT



The International Training for Young Leaders which is held for 14 years under the auspices of Prof. Dr. Gjorge Ivanov, President of the Republic of Macedonia 2009-2019, has grown into a recognizable and established brand, School for Young Leaders of President Ivanov.

The School for Young Leaders is a project of the President of the Republic of Macedonia 2009-2019, Prof. Dr. Gjorge Ivanov, primarily initiated in his first electoral program in 2009, following his idea and vision to enable the young, talented and ambitious people from Macedonia to upgrade and improve their skills, to develop their creativity and managerial capacities. The School has been traditionally organized since 2010.

So far, in the previous eleven Schools, more than 500 young people from Macedonia and abroad have participated, with a different academic and professional focus but similar achievements and ambitions. The previous 13 generations of participants followed lectures of over 300 renowned lecturers from around the world.

The project is primarily funded by the private sector.

In 2018, the School for Young Leaders of President Ivanov was recognized as the Best Socially Responsible Project in Europe for 2017 by the World Forum of Business Angels.



THE PROJECT



The mission of the School is to stimulate positive values among young leaders and future political, cultural, and economic leaders of our country and develop their capacity to meet the challenges of global technology, international competition, and cultural and religious diversification.

The program is intended for young people with higher education, under the age of 35, graduates, and young professionals. Through lectures, simulations, real examples, illustrations practical exercises and training, the students are given the opportunity to become familiar with the practices of true leadership.

The vision of the School for Young Leaders, as a training center with high standards and responsibility for the integration of the modern political, scientific and technological knowledge and skills, is to establish a new model in the leaders' education and advancement of their personal and leadership skills in their living and working environments.




